

CNMC Luanshya Holding Ground-breaking Ceremony for The Slag Reclamation Project

At 10am on October 28, 2013 local time, CNMC Luanshya Copper Mines Plc (hereinafter referred to as “CNMC Luanshya”), an enterprise of CNMCL in Zambia, held the ground-breaking ceremony for its slag reclamation project at the Baluba Ore Dressing Plant.

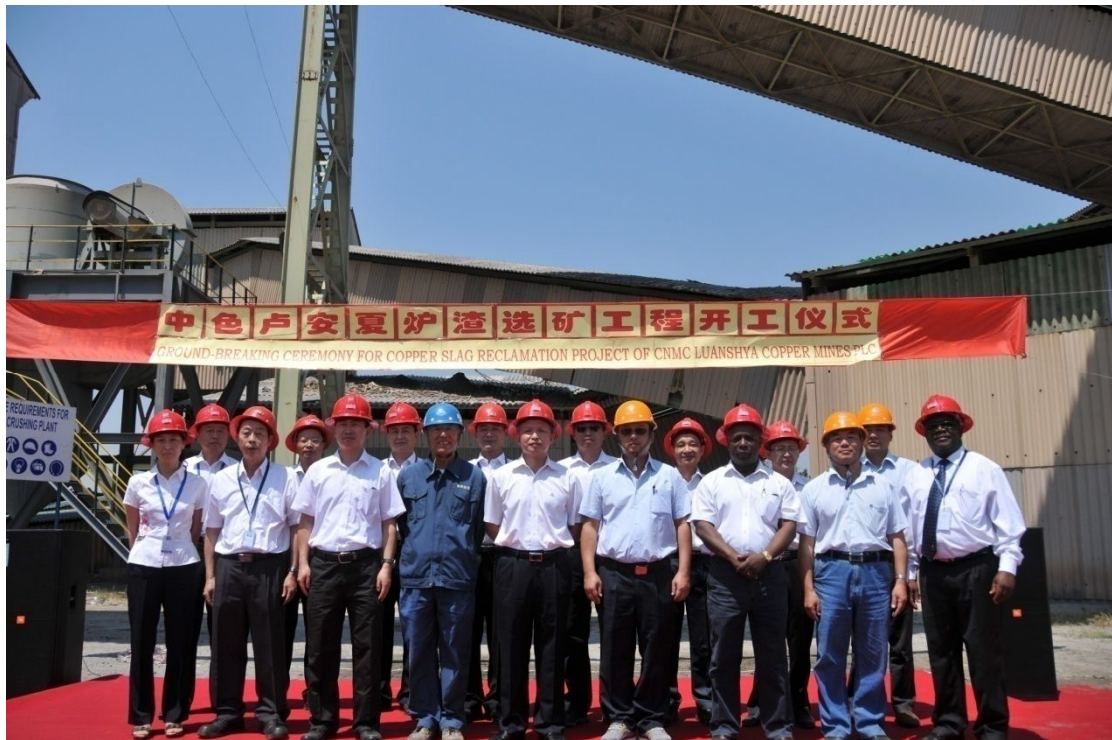
According to its design, the slag reclamation project involves a total investment of about 20.13 million USD and is capable of processing 500,000 tons of smelting slag each year. It is another important new project of CNMC Luanshya after the Muliashi Project. On the basis of making full use of the existing equipment and facilities of the Baluba Ore Dressing Plant, the project adopts the advanced ore dressing technologies, equipment, and automatic control technologies to recover the valuable metals from smelting slag. While creating economic benefit, it prolongs the production lifespan of the Baluba Mine, gives local employees work opportunity, reduces environmental protection workload in keeping solid materials on the surface for a long period, and creates good social benefits. At the ground-breaking ceremony, Mr. LuoXingeng, executive director

of CNMCL and president of CNMC Luanshya, solemnly states that like Muliashi Project, the slag reclamation project has great significance to CNMC Luanshya. It will play a positive role in promoting the sustainable and healthy development of CNMCL and CNMC Luanshya and in benefiting Luanshya people and promoting the development of mining economy of Zambia.
