
## A Delegation from the Ministry of Land and Resources Headed by Department Chief Liu Lianhe Paying an Investigating Visit to CNMC Luanshya

On May 29, 2013 local time, a delegation from the Ministry of Land and Resources headed by Liu Lianhe, chief of the Mineral Development Management Department of the said Ministry, paid an investigating visit to CNMC Luanshya, one of CNMCL's enterprises in Zambia.
